### **HISTORY TO BEHOLD**

Monroe County Courthouse, circa 1895, boasts pressed tin ceilings and plenty of photo-worthy spots.

Monroe County-Forsyth War Memorial and the Confederate Soldier Memorial will please fans of battles and bravery, and pick up a Forsyth City Cemetry Tour from the Welcome Center for more stories of our dearly departed.

Historic Train Depots from the 1800s are within walking distance of the courthouse, and are home to the Monroe County History Museum.

William Hubbard Complex - The grounds house the Hubbard Museum & Cultural Center, stocked with timelines, memorabilia, class histories, lists of employees, and much more. The complex also houses Telling Our Story: Black History Museum, which contains many items covering African American achievements, milestones, family memories and records.
